The Lady Legacy Metro Championship—2025

- ◆ Date: Tuesday, September 30, 2025
- ◆ RAIN Date: Wednesday, November 18, 2025
- ◆ Place: Greystone Golf Club, Founders Course
- ◆ ALL FLIGHTS WILL PLAY STABLEFORD FORMAT (POINTS).
- ◆ 18 hole shotgun start at 9 AM.
- ◆ Play will be in groups of 3. Nine (9) players per flight.
- ◆ All players will be flighted by handicap. IF YOUR INDEX/HANDICAP IS GREATER THAN 18, YOU HAVE THE OPTION TO MAKE YOUR OWN THREESOME. (Include pairings note with entry form.)
- ◆ Maximum entrants: 72 players
- ◆ THE CHAMPION WILL BE THE INDIVIDUAL MAKING THE MOST TOTAL POINTS . ALL OTHER AWARDS are based on most points over quota within your flight..
- ◆ Ties will be determined by score card playoff per USGA rules.

The Lady Legacy Metro Championship is an annual event for the Birmingham, Alabama area's amateur golfers, whether they usually play on public or private courses, to identify the champion of the Birmingham metropolitan area.

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to all female amateur golfers, who are residents of, OR members of golf clubs, in Jefferson, Shelby, Walker, St. Clair, Blount or Tuscaloosa counties for a minimum of 30 days prior to the close of entries for the Championship and have a certifiable USGA Handicap Index of no more than 36 as of September 15, 2025.

The Lady Legacy Scholarship Foundation (LLSF) will be the final authority in determining whether a handicap that has been presented qualifies as a USGA certified handicap. The LLSF will refuse entry to any applicant who cannot demonstrate her eligibility to the LLSF's satisfaction according to the eligibility criteria above.

The Lady Legacy Scholarship Foundation has the right to reject any entry or disqualify any contestant at any time.

COST

The entry fee is \$120 and includes greens and cart fees during the competition, range balls, awards, and lunch after play.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

All entries must be filed on the official Entry Application Form or a photocopy of the form and must be received by 5PM September 15, 2025. Applicants will be notified promptly whether their entry is accepted.

If any applicant withdraws prior to the entry deadline, her entry fee will be refunded upon request. No refunds will be made after the entry deadline, subject to the discretion of the LLSF. All dates refer to date of receipt of entry and not the postmark date.

CADDIES AND CARTS

CADDIES ARE NOT PERMITTED. No spectator carts are allowed. Contestants are not permitted to carry their own bags. Cart use is required by the contestants.

PRACTICE PRIVILEGE

Greystone will extend practice privileges to contestants only on Sept. 17, 18, 19, 24 or 27. Cost will be \$56. You must call the Golf shop to arrange a tee time. Limit of ONE practice round per participant.

DRESS

Proper Golf attire is required and will be strictly enforced. **(No tennis skirts, or halter type tops please).**
